Lux families,

This is our last full week of school before the end of the semester. Next week, students will attend school Monday and Tuesday only. Winter Break is scheduled for December 23 through January 4, and second semester begins Tuesday, January 5.

Make a plan to complete and turn in past work and prepare for upcoming deadlines. Also, keep current on important communications from teachers about what's happening in the classroom.

Tuesday is a PLC Day

TOMORROW, Tuesday, December 15, is a PLC Day. Lux will dismiss at 1:40pm. Buses will NOT run until 3pm. Any students still on Lux grounds at 2pm will be directed to study hall. Students in study hall can leave only when the buses arrive or when a parent or sibling picks them up (unless we have permission from parents that they may leave with someone else). Parents or siblings should call the Lux Office (402-436-1220) when they arrive to have their student dismissed.

Upcoming school choice deadlines

- Special Attendance Permits are due January 5.
- <u>High School Choice Forms</u> (for 8th graders wanting to attend a high school other than their home high school) are due January 31. Fill out a High School Choice form ONLY if your student wants to attend a high school outside of your assigned school area. For example, if you live in the East High area and your student wants to attend East, you DO NOT need to fill out the form. If you live in the East area and your student wants to attend Southeast, you NEED to fill out the form.

East High School students will be offering virtual tutoring with Lux students every Wednesday from 3:05-3:45pm. Pass/Fail (Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory) Grade

Students taking High School classes (including 8th grade world language and/or Algebra or higher-level math) have until December 22, 2020, to choose to receive S/U grading. There will not be a limit on the number of courses a student can elect S/U grading for the first semester of the 20-21 school year.

 The LPS Board Regulation regarding Honor Roll qualification still applies: Students with a 3.5 or higher weighted GPA on the previous semester's coursework, including at least 30 graded credits (not included S/U) in a block school and 25 graded credits (not included S/U) in a non-block school are eligible for the Honor Roll.
