Lux families,

Students taking High School classes (including 8th grade world language and/or Algebra or higher-level math) have until December 22, 2020, to choose to receive S/U grading. There will not be a limit on the number of courses a student can elect S/U grading for the first semester of the 20-21 school year.

- The LPS Board Regulation regarding Honor Roll qualification still applies: Students with a 3.5 or higher weighted GPA on the previous semester's coursework, including at least 30 graded credits (not included S/U) in a block school and 25 graded credits (not included S/U) in a non-block school are eligible for the Honor Roll.
