Upcoming school choice deadlines

- <u>Special Attendance Permits</u> are due January 5.
- <u>High School Choice Forms</u> (for 8th graders wanting to attend a high school other than their home high school) are due January 31. Fill out a High School Choice form ONLY if your student wants to attend a high school outside of your assigned school area. For example, if you live in the East High area and your student wants to attend East, you DO NOT need to fill out the form. If you live in the East area and your student wants to attend Southeast, you NEED to fill out the form.

Remote Learning updates:

For students who are Remote Learning, please remember that the following classes are not available for Zoom Instruction: Design Thinking (6th grade), Family & Consumer Science (FCS 8th grade), Skilled & Technical Science courses (STS), Drama (8th grade), & Publications (8th grade). Instead of Zooming into these classes, please use that time to work on homework, read a book, or do something active (exercise, do a chore around the house, go for a walk, etc.)

Here are some tips to get the most out of being a Zoom Learner:

1. **RISE & SHINE**: Before 8:00, take a shower, get dressed for the day, brush your hair, eat a healthy breakfast, brush your teeth, & drink a glass of water.

2. **BE ON TIME:** Login to your computer a few minutes BEFORE 8:00 each day. Be sure to be on time to the rest of your classes throughout the day.

3. **PRIVATE CHAT**: Each teacher will have his/her own procedures for chat. Please follow those procedures to ensure chat does not become a distraction to learning.

4. **BE PREPARED:** Have your computer charged, camera on, and have a notebook, pencil, and other needed materials handy. Be in a quiet room with no distractions.

5. **PAY ATTENTION & PARTICIPATE:** Have your camera on (unless you have made arrangements with your teacher). Stay focused. Raise your hand or notify your teacher at an appropriate time if you have questions. Remember that the expectation is that you will be engaged in learning the entire class period (not just at the beginning and the end).

6. **STAY MUTED:** Unless you are in a breakout room, stay muted until your teacher calls on you to avoid talking over others.
